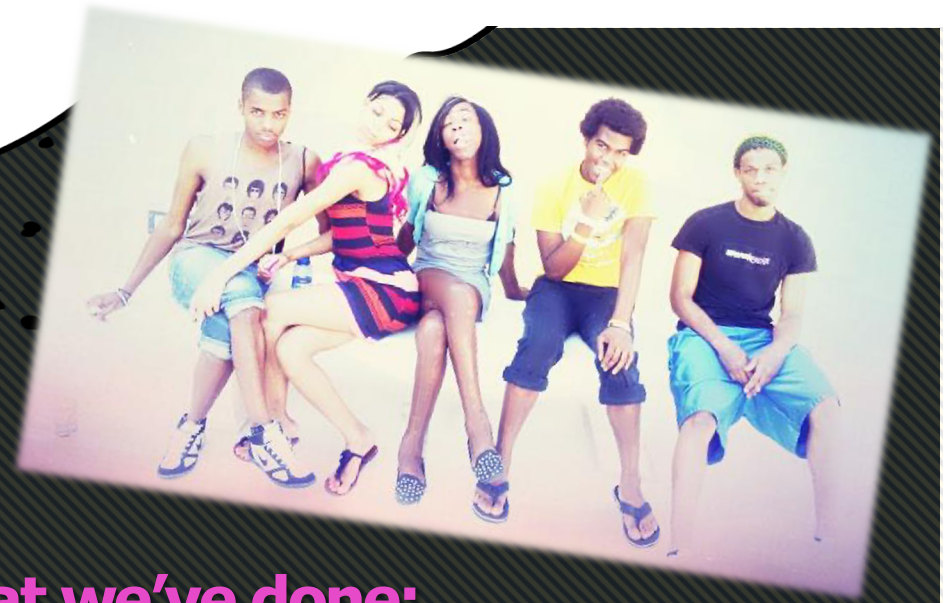

What we do:

BreakOUT! seeks to end the criminalization of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and questioning (LGBTQ) youth to build a safer and more just New Orleans.

We build on the rich cultural tradition of resistance in the South to build the power of LGBTQ youth through youth organizing, healing justice, and leadership development programs.

What we've done:

- ★ Secured the adoption of New Orleans Police Department (NOPD) Policy 402 which prohibits the profiling by the police on the basis of gender expression, gender identity, or sexual orientation on the 44th anniversary of the historic Stonewall riots;
- ★ Launched a GED Program specifically for *BreakOUT!* members with the Youth Empowerment Project's NOPLAY GED Program;
- ★ Developed "Say My Name," a theatre performance in partnership with Ping Chong + Company that shares the real life stories of 5 transgender young women and resistance in the face of criminalization;
- ★ Launched *Get Yr Rights*, a national LGBTQ youth network with Streetwise and Safe (NYC) to create a network of youth staying safe on the streets;
- ★ Amplified LGBTQ youth voices locally and nationally, and brought members to conferences in Detroit, Atlanta, Jackson, Oakland, Houston, *and more!*
